The image shows the Fisherman’s Bastion (Halászbástya) in Budapest, Hungary. It is a terrace in neo-Gothic and neo-Romanesque style situated on the Buda bank of the Danube River. The Fisherman’s Bastion is a neo-Gothic and neo-Romanesque style terrace located on the Buda bank of the Danube River. It was built between 1895 and 1902 and was designed by architect Frigyes Schulek.



The image shows the Hungarian Parliament Building, a neo-Gothic masterpiece located in Budapest, Hungary, on the banks of the Danube River. It is the seat of the National Assembly of Hungary and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The building is the tallest in Budapest and the third-largest parliament building in the world. The interior of the building is decorated with 40 kilograms of 23-carat gold.
